"From the lab to the newsroom: how to start a career in science communication"

In an era when fake news compete on an equal footing with peer-reviewed research, rigorous science communication is desperately needed. Science communication means communicating about STEM or medicine to general readers through different channels, e.g. newspapers, magazines, blogs, books, television, podcasts, museum exhibits, and documentaries. Science journalist Giorgia Guglielmi will guide us through her journey from the lab to the newsroom and tell us how scientists can become professional science communicators.

After her PhD at EMBL, Giorgia did a Master's in Science Writing at the Massachusetts Institute of Technology. She has worked with the news teams of Nature and Science, and now she freelances from Cambridge, MA. Her stories have appeared in Scientific American, Science, Nature, and more.
